### **RECOMMENDATION**

Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign the renewal of Revenue Agreement No. 7065 with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for a maximum of \$5,894 for the term October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016 for reimbursement of expenditures for activities related to Light Brown Apple Moth exclusion program.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Approval of the requested action will renew the County's agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for reimbursement of services for the Light Brown Apple Moth exclusion program consisting of implementing Federal Domestic Quarantine Order *Epiphyas postvittana* (Light Brown Apple Moth) DA-2011-41; including implementation of the regulations for parallel California Quarantine, CCR 3434 and to conduct emergency response activities as a result of detections of light brown apple moth in regulated establishments.

### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

The authorization of this agreement with California Department of Food and Agriculture provides for reimbursement to the County for Light Brown Apple Moth inspections performed according to the terms of the agreement to insure Napa County can control the movement in interstate commerce of any plant, plant part, or article if the Secretary determines that the prohibition of restriction is necessary to prevent the dissemination of a plant pest with the United States.
