BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

On March 8, 2005, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 05-40 authorizing the Auditor-Controller to accept donations that are equal to or less than \$1,000 on behalf of the Board of Supervisors. The Resolution in March 2005 does not supersede the following:

- 1. Resolution 99-56 adopted on behalf of the Library on June 1, 1999 to accept donations from various donors and the Friends of the Valley;
- 2. Board approval for Probation to accept donations on behalf of the Chamberlain High School Fund on December 2, 2003; and
- 3. Board Resolution adopted on June 27, 2006 and December 9, 2008 for the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) to accept donations on behalf of the Homeless Shelter (Resolution 06-120) and the Child Recovery Center (CRC) and Child Welfare Services (CWS) (Resolution 08-171).

On August 1, 2005, the Auditor-Controller's Office established procedures based on Resolution 05-40. The donations accepted on behalf of the Board of Supervisors were recorded into a Donation Revenue account with the County Treasury.

A summary of the donations received County-wide for the quarter ended September 30, 2020 is attached.
