RECOMMENDATION

Director of Public Works requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign a Space License Agreement with the Wildlife Rescue Center of Napa County, for the use of office space at 7292 Silverado Trail, with no license fee, for the term July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2020.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Approval of this Space License Agreement will allow the Wildlife Rescue Center to continue to use of County Space at 7292 Silverado Trail to continue to house wildlife rehabilitative care and public awareness operations in Napa County.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The Wildlife Rescue Center provides rehabilitative care to ill, injured, or orphaned wildlife, and promotes public awareness through community outreach in the County of Napa. On December 14, 2010, the Board approved Space License Agreement 7517 to house the Wildlife Rescue Center of Napa County. However, Agreement 7517 will expire June 30, 2015. Approval of this Space License Agreement will authorize the Wildlife Rescue Center to continue to utilize space at 7292 Silverado Trail to house its Wildlife Rescue operations.
