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### **RECOMMENDATION**

County Executive Officer requests approval of and authorization for the Chair to sign the renewal of revenue Agreement No. 3295 with the State of California for a maximum of \$55,600 for the term July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006 for the Arts in Mental Health Program.

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This is an annual revenue contract with the State Department of Mental Health to fund a contract with the Arts Council of Napa Valley for the provision of an art program at Napa State Hospital.

**BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

Today's action approves an agreement with the State of California in the amount of \$55,600 for the Arts in Mental Health program. This program provides an arts program to residents of Napa State Hospital. These funds cannot be directly allocated to a private non-profit agency. Therefore, these State funds will be passed through the County to the Arts Council of Napa Valley to carry out the program. Appropriations were included in the recommended 05-06 final budget for County Contributions (with offsetting revenue from the State of California). Napa County will not be responsible for any expenses relating to this agreement beyond what funds the State allocates for this program. There is no cost to the County for this program.
