EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

County Executive Officer seeks discussion and possible action on SB 109 (Dodd) that would establish the Office of Wildfire Technology Research and Development within the Office of Emergency Services. The bill would make the office responsible for studying, testing, and advising regarding procurement of emerging technologies and tools in order to more effectively prevent and suppress wildfires, and serving as the central organizing hub for the state government's identification of emerging wildfire technologies, as provided.
