REQUESTED ACTION: Adoption of Resolution 2022-07 creating an Ad-hoc Committee to assist in hiring a new Executive Director.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The current Executive Director of the Authority has notified the Board of his decision to retire in the near future. Staff is recommending that the Board establish a two member ad hoc personnel committee to work with staff on the recruitment and screening of potential candidates to fill this pending vacancy.

The attached resolution would establish the committee with two Directors selected by the Board. It would also waive Section 18b of the Authority's Bylaws insofar as it could be interpreted as requiring the ad hoc committee to comply with the Brown Act. Ad hoc committees consisting of less than a quorum of a legislative body are exempt from the Brown Act pursuant to Government Code section 54952(b).
