EMPLOYEE DEFERRED COMPENSATION PROGRAM

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to discuss inclusion in the County of Napa employees 457 plan and/or the creation of a separate plan for the NVWMA employees.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Authority Manager has been working with the County to be included in the County of Napa's employee deferred compensation plan. On May 17, 2007 the Napa County Deferred Compensation Board considered authorizing the Chair to send a letter to the Board of Supervisors recommending that it adopt a resolution allowing the Authority to be an associated employer for the purpose of providing either a 457 deferred compensation plan, or 401A deferred compensation plan, or both to the employees of the Authority. The motion was made but failed to pass on a 2-2 vote.
