SUBJECT: Determination of Members' Calendar Year's Waste Quantities

RECOMMENDATION

DETERMINATION OF MEMBERS' CALENDAR YEAR'S WASTE QUANTITIES

REQUESTED ACTION: Determination of the Members' prior calendar year's waste quantities to be used to set the next fiscal year's weighted voting as described in Section 8.3(c) of the Authority's joint powers formation agreement.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Authority's joint powers formation agreement requires weighted voting for specific items [Section 8.3c)]. Section 8.4 then states how the weighted voting shall be determined:

As part of the fiscal year budget setting process, the determination of the MEMBERS' prior calendar years' waste quantities shall be made and approved by the AUTHORITY'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS. The recorded waste tonnage quantities delivered to the AUTHORITY'S FACILITIES from each of the MEMBERS' franchised solid waste collection companies for the prior calendar year of January 1 to December 31 shall be used to set the next FISCAL YEAR's weighted voting as described in Section 8.3(c).

The attached table expresses the last calendar year's waste tonnages delivered by the four members' franchisees. Based on the tonnages delivered by the four members the City of American Canyon represented 7.49 %, the City of Napa 40.00%, the City of Vallejo 46.95 %, and the County of Napa 5.55%.
