DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: Staff to provide an update on the status of activities relevant to the Act.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

<u>Grants and Payment Funds</u> - The state (CalRecycle) has notified Napa County that it will restore recycling and litter reduction payments for fiscal years 2009-2010 and 2010-2011. The full amount of the grant is \$25,000 per year (with approximately \$20,000 of that allocated to the upvalley area), so \$50,000 total should be available for beverage container recycling activities over the next fiscal year. However, as of writing this agenda item CalRecycle has not yet released these funds.

<u>Composting Workshops</u> - The composting workshop program includes one more class in the up-valley area. It will be held on Saturday, August 28 at 9:00 a. m. at the White Barn in St. Helena. Sign-ups are accepted at http://cityofnapa.org/compost
